



Man charged on suspicion of manslaughter

A gas fitter has been arrested on suspicion of manslaughter. This was the result of the death of a 24 year old woman from Bath who died from carbon monoxide poisoning on 30th December last year.

It is alleged that on 16th December 2010 he installed a boiler and failed to ensure that the flue pipe was safe.
